SkyWay Innovations: Why Has SkyWay Transport Moved over from Lithuania to Belarus?

After the successful presentation of SkyWay transport that has brought together 5,000 guests in Belarus, news from Lithuania came. The pre-trial investigation of Anatoly Yunitskiy's activities, which lasted three years, is discontinued. It was closed since no evidence confirming the suspicions had been collected during the investigation. The business moved over to Belarus, where SkyWay Technologies Co. has created more than 300 jobs. The Company consists of the certification center EcoTechnoPark, nine project designing departments, a pilot production facility and business departments.



The General designer of SkyWay transport Anatoly Yunitskiy comments, — “Innovations have always experienced additional risks, one of which is the rejection by the elites on a separate territory. We have successfully completed the relocation of the business to Belarus, where the climate for innovations is positive. Indeed, there is a request for the return of the technology to Lithuania, but, as the proverb says, — “all in its proper time”.

The technology has proved its viability on EcoTechnoPark territory near the town of Maryina Gorka in Belarus, where the first innovative transport and infrastructure systems have been built. The Soviet engineering school has given to the world many developments in transport, but their implementation often does not have proper dynamics due to a bureaucratic climate. A couple of years ago such initiatives were not perceived seriously, but time has proved their efficiency and this innovative transport operates already today.

There is a hope that the Lithuanian precedent and successful development in Belarus will close once and forever the subject of doubts and will relieve SkyWay from various unjust accusations. While maintaining the positive dynamics of management, creation and implementation of innovations will contribute to the economic development of Belarus and Russia, where technology is also of interest in the regions of Siberia.



The move was due to the fact that the authorities in Belarus accept the opinion of the innovative community. President Alexander Lukashenko promises enhanced support for the development of the IT-sector and innovations. According to the draft Decree that is currently being prepared, they will provide the necessary assistance including a legislative one to the organizations in this sector. All levels of government are watching with interest the development of EcoTechnoPark and the movement towards the innovative sector is the best proof of the importance of SkyWay for the country and the entire Eurasian region.

The exhibition RailwayTech in Indonesia and Smart Cities in India showed the demand for SkyWay transport in many Asian countries. Now we are opening offices in India (two at once – in Delhi and Pune) and in Indonesia. The Company is focused on creating long-term partnerships with local building and EPC-companies, manufacturers, certification bodies, relevant ministries and financial circles. Owing to the innovative nature of the technology, the selection of strong local partners is a priority for the development of SkyWay in any region.
